

Paper Miniature Posters

These posters are created for use generally with modern or futuristic paper sets. While they were created for use with the *Cheapsville 3035* N-scale paper miniatures set available from MicroTactix™ (<http://www.microtactix.com>), they can be used with other sets as well – notably their *Starbase Omega 3* and *Cheapsville* lines.

The artwork is taken from a variety of sources, mainly early 20th century Spanish and Russian political and movie posters. The Coke ads are also early 20th century. All of these posters are reasonably visible at the printed sizes, and can be used as posters, billboards, and other artwork and signage.

To use, simply clip and paste onto the miniatures as desired. I recommend printing on the same paper stock as your existing miniatures, and using the same glueing methods. Posters can be cut to any desired size, by either trimming excess words and art or leaving a white border around. Be creative. Posters can also be ripped, charred, tattered, stained, or punched with holes as desired.
