

MATCH PLAY 2009

Welcome to this year's CLGK Match Play Tournament. In order to ensure smooth tournament play, please be mindful of the following guidelines and feel free to contact me should you have any questions in this regard. Good luck to everyone!

Guidelines:

1. Matches can be played any day of the week or during regular CLGK tournament dates. It is incumbent upon the players to contact each other to schedule and play a match with the timelines prescribed (Every player this year does have an e-mail address so communication should be easy). Because some matches last year took months to schedule and play, failure to play your match within reasonable proximity to timeline may result in forfeiture of match.
2. If you would like to play your match at a CLGK tournament please inform Al Dagys that you would like to play your match at that tournament.
3. Matches are played hole by hole based on the difference in course handicaps.
4. It is recommended that matches be played head-to-head as opposed to 'blind play' where you play in separate foursomes and match cards. Although playing blind is acceptable, it cheapens the competitive experience.
5. All results of completed matches are to be immediately communicated to me for posting. I will then send an e-mail to notify the two players that they have to play each other in the next round.
6. Remember to decide a tiebreaker option method prior to play. It is recommended to either play a playoff hole or play another round of 18 holes.
