The following two obituaries of Donald and Margaret.

### **MARGARET -**

The death occurred at Colville Road, Lot 31, on June 6, 1904, after a few days illness of Margaret MacDonald, beloved wife of Donald Docherty, aged eighty-five years. She was born in Glashvin, Belfast, PEI, and was the daughter of the late Murdock MacDonald, of Belfast. Mr MacDonald and his wife were among the immigrants who came to the Island in the celebrated ship "Polly", in 1803. Mrs. Docherty was converted in early life under the faithful preaching of the late loved and revered, Rev. John McLennan. She was a retiring disposition, the love of kindness was on her tongue, and a faithful member of the Presbyterian Church. She leaves to mourn a loving husband, now in his eighty-sixth year, who will miss her very much; one son, John, on the Homestead, Sarah, wife of John Buchanan, living at Pinette,; Mary, wife of Neil Campbell, of Quincy, Mass; and eleven grandchildren who will miss grama's loving care. One daughter, Annie pre-deceased her. She was loved and respected in the community in which she lived, and by all who had the pleasure of her acquaintance. She has now exchanged the shadow for reality and so the just passeth away.

### **DONALD-**

At Colville Road, Lot 31, PEI on January 7, 1906 death entered the midst and claimed the oldest and highly respected neighbour in the person of Donald Docherty. He leaves one son and two daughters, John on the homestead; Sarah, wife of John Buchanan, Pinette, Belfast; Mary, Wife of Neil Campbell; Jane, wife of Anthony Buchanan, beside twelve grandchildren. He was eighty nine years of age and literally passed away in the fullness of his years. He had no organic disease whatsoever and enjoyed the best of health. Up until one week previous to his death, he had the use of all his facilities with the exception of his memory which was somewhat defective. He was the son of the late Donald Docherty, Seal River, Lot 50 who emigrated to this Island on the celebrated ship "Polly" in 1803. He also leaves one brother Murdock of Victoria Cross, PEI, the last survivor of a numerous family.
