

Using Back Slashes

Use back slashes as follows:

- **In server, file, and folder names**, e.g., G:\Pio\Officially Released Documents\Release Notes\DLO\V40_DLO.doc.
- **To refer to two items as a single unit** when the items are closely related and one holds a subordinate position to the other. Use a back slash between the two, placing the subordinate element second.

Example: ATO\Secondary Sales & Trading
(Secondary Sales & Trading is a module in ATO)
ACO\Deal & Loan Origination
(Deal & Loan Originating is a module in ACO)

Using Forward Slashes

A forward slash indicates alternatives or to refers to two equal elements as single unit.

Information may be used/re-used by all authorized individuals.

This documentation is for DLO/PSS, which are two modules being marketed as a package.
