Lesson 1 Personality and Deity of Holy Spirit

Needs:

copy of p66-72 from Knowing God, Packer whiteboard & markers or flip pad and markers thinking caps verses to hand out lab coat 3x5 cards for questions 3x5 cards for snail-mail accountability volunteer Handout discussing the Deity of H.S.

Wear lab coat.
Bring "Thinking Caps" for everyone to wear

Explain the lesson series

Say: Series on Holy Spirit. Study who the Spirit is. Aspects of the Spirit's ministry. What we gain from the Spirit. I chose this topic because it is very important; I haven't seen it addressed anywhere lately; and I wanted to learn about it. As such, this is fairly new to me, and if I am wrong in some of my teaching, I'm sorry.

Explain the need for information as well as the applicational stuff

Say: This is mostly an informational study. We might even have to think a bit. To aid us with this potential difficulty, I've brought these handy thinking-caps, which you should all put on right now. Because it is informational, the applications may be a bit hard to see at times, but I will strive to make it relevant to your daily life. However, if the applications seem a stretch, don't worry because the following series will have more applications than you can shake a stick at.

Say: As always, I am trying new ways to effectively communicate the information. Bear with me if things seem too fast or too slow. Hopefully, I'll get it just right sometimes.

Say: Before we start, and get into various aspects of the Holy Spirit, let me suggest one thing: In the midst of all this, keep in mind that the primary work of the Holy Spirit is to glorify God (John 16:13-14) and so doing will make Christ known (1 John 4:2-3).

Select volunteer, and bring to front

Ask: How do we know they have a personality? What traits, actions, behaviors do they exhibit that show evidence of a personality?

Write traits on whiteboard.

Summarize:

I = intellect

A = actions E = emotions

O = other

Pass around verses (both personality and deity) to everyone

Have everyone read their own verse quietly and determine what it tells about the H.S.

Go around

Read verse

State what they found

Write it down on whiteboard, categorize it

I = intellect

A = actions

E = emotions

O = other

D = divine

Ask: A while ago we listed traits to show evidence of our volunteer's personality. Now we have similar traits for the H.S. Is it reasonable to conclude that the H.S. has a personality?

Ask: We have these other traits here, that I marked with a "D". What do those possibly tell about the H.S.?

(give handout on deity of H.S.)

Ask: Who cares? What does it matter if the H.S. has a personality? What does it matter if the H.S. is divine?

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(Personality \Rightarrow Person \Rightarrow not a force)
(Deity \Rightarrow Godhood)
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Reasons for caring:

Hand out and Read passage in Knowing God p71-72

H.S. grieves over our $\sin \Rightarrow$ H.S. cares for us

Consellor ⇒ a person guides and leads; a force merely pushes and moves

We lost Jesus in the flesh, and we gained His spirit. Our "replacement" is of equal power, authority, divinity. This is not a "My savior left the earth and all I got is this lousy T-shirt" kind of thing.

Divine \Rightarrow unlimited \Rightarrow can serve all people

Give H.S. equal honor and attention to God and Jesus

Application

Do not grieve the Holy Spirit

I think that it is necessary to internalize this - to make it part of your mindset in ordinary life. The application is easy: Stop sinning. Don't grieve the H.S. Work on this, and God will change your life.

To indicate the indwelling, I have some cookies for you. Today, after lunch and dinner, when these cookies are indwelling you, take a moment to consider what it means for the H.S. to indwell you. Consider what you might have done differently if you had thought about not grieving the H.S. during the day..

Lesson 3 Baptizing and Filling

I am going to summarize the main point on Baptism of H.S.

1 Cor 12:13

All believers are baptized (look @ audience - a motley group) into one body of Christ

Eph 4:5 context is unity - one body only one baptism

Rom 6:1-10???

Baptism by H.S. is experience once by all believers at salvation. (1 Cor 12:13, Eph 4:5) It effects our unification with the body of Christ. (1 Cor 12:13, Eph 4:5) It is not a guarantee of power. (1 Cor 12:13)

Non-experiential work - we don't get visions and powers and stuff from it

For power, some "filling" is useful...

Ask What happens if you drink a large amount of alcohol?

Ask What happens to your behavior?

You get drunk
Your behavior is affected
You lose control to some extent

Eph 5:18-21

Ask What contrast is made in v18?

Ask What does this indicate about the nature of being filled with H.S.?

Also not - this is a command, not a suggestion.

Ask Given the context, what might filling entail?

Ask Is it always a display of miraculous power?

Ask Is it more than a warm, fuzzy feeling?

It interesting to note that there is no occurrence of believers being told to wait for the filling of the H.S.

It is interesting to note that there is no example (after Pentecost) of anyone praying to be filled.

Rom 12:1-2

Note: the tense of "to present" is agrist; it indicates an unrepeated event

Ask What are we called to do? (v1)

Ask how much of our lives does this take?

our body -> actions, existence

Note: the tense in v2 is the imperfective: "stop being conformed"

Ask Subsequent to the initial and complete dedication of ourselves to God, what are we called to do?

Ask what is involved? *mind -> thoughts, attidtudes*

It takes inital (complete) dedication, and continual separation (unto God)

1 John 1:9

It also takes confession of sins - a continual dedication. An implication from this and other verses, is that sin breaks the control of the Spirit in our lives.

Ask So, what do we get from this? (rhetorical)

Gal 5:16 Gal 5:22-23 Eph 5:18-21

Ask What kinds of things do we get from being filled with the Spirit?

Ask What might your life be like if you were continually filled with the Spirit?

Application & Conclusion

Think of one way in which you "grieve the Spirit" (Eph 4:30). Determine how to stop it. (Can you just quit? Do you need someone to hold you accountable? Do you need to change certain other behaviors?) Do it.

Choose one action associated with being filled that you would like to strengthen. Determine how that would fit into your life. Do it.

Do a craft. Make a thing to hang on door, or desk, or carry with you to remind you of what you are trying to strengthen.

Say Remember, the church in Corinth was a motley group. The city was an important city in world commerce; and had an idolatrous religion.

Read 1 Cor 12:1-11

vv1-3

Why is Paul writing this section of his letter?

What do we learn about the Spirit's involvement in the glorification of Jesus?

vv4-11

What is contrasted in vv4, 5, 6, 7, 11 (horizontal)

Likewise, what things are comparable between the verses (vertical)

What then, is the general contrast being made?

What does this teach about how God works through His people?

Read 1 Cor 12:12-27

vv12-14 many members, one body

What analogy does Paul make between believers and the human body?

How is it that all christians are in one body?

What does this say about you, as a child of God?

vv15-20 many members necessary to make one body

In vv1-11 we saw that though there is one God, there are many methods God uses through His children. How does Paul further develop that unity-through-diversity concept in this passage? (give specific physical analogues)

How can I compare my place in the church to that of my brother or sister?

vv21-25 those members which seem less honorable are given special honor

In our physical bodies, we know that the little toe is not as important as the foot, or brain. What does Paul say about such parts in the body of Christ?

Why has God given even more honor to what might to us seem to be a less appealing position? How can I compare my place in the church to that of my brother or sister?

vv26-27 each member is affected by the operation of the entire body

How does the state of one believer affect another believer?

How do your ordeals impact the church as a whole?

What is the theme of this chapter, so far?

The start of this chapter Paul was talking about spiritual gifts. What is their purpose?

Say For this week, you have homework, which is vitally important for next week

- 1) Consider your own skills, talents, and desires. Write them out
- 2) Ask friend(s) to tell you what they think your skills and motivations are
- 3) Pray for guidance & wisdom
- 4) Bring list of skills next week
