LIONS CLUBS INTERNATIONAL Multiple District 60 APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND GUIDELINES FOR

PROPOSED REGIONAL LEADERSHIP INSTITUTE

Georgetown, Guyana November 11-13, 2001

What is the MD60 Regional Leadership Institute?

The MD60 Regional Leadership Institute is a program sponsored by Lions clubs International in collaboration with MD60 for the purpose of building the skills of <u>Senior Lions</u> and <u>Emerging Lion leaders</u> to prepare them for leadership responsibilities at the club, zone, region, and district levels in the Multiple District. The Theme: <u>"Leadership for the 21st. Century"</u>

What are the Objectives of the Leadership Institute?

The launching Regional Leadership Institutes by the Multiple District is designed to prepare 21st. century Lion leaders who can think outside the box, and help formulate a vision to make LCI the organization of choice for quality people who see Lionism as an opportunity for personal growth, service and satisfaction. These Lion leaders will understand the requirements for building a quality organization, and learn leadership skills and strategies for developing effective clubs. The institute will offer participants a motivating and empowering experience in leadership.

The objectives of the Leadership Institute are to equip Lions, drawn from subdistrict 60A and 60B of Multiple District 60 with leadership skills that would enable them to effectively assume positions of responsibility in the Multiple District.

Who will be eligible to attend the leadership Institute?

The Leadership Institute is open to <u>Senior Lions</u> and <u>Emerging Lion Leaders</u> from Sub-district 60A or Sub-District 60B who meet the eligibility requirements for selection:

- 1. <u>Senior Lions:</u> Candidates must be Lions in good standing who are serving or previously served successfully as club president, but have not yet attained the position Vice-District Governor. Zone or Region chairmen and currently serving or past club Presidents will be considered as candidates.
- 2. <u>Emerging Lion Leaders:</u> Candidates must be Lions in good standing with five years or less of membership. They must have served successfully on a club committee and have not yet attained the position of Club President. Club Vice-presidents or those who aspire to this office will be considered as candidates.
- 3. Candidates do not have to hold a position currently.
- 4. Candidates must be willing to commit to attend the full three-day institute.

5. Candidates must commit to completing the "Practicum" leading to full certification as a Leadership Trainer. The Practicum will involve successfully organizing and arranging a leadership seminar or workshop of at least 1 hour in length at the club or Zone level, with at least 15 Lions or Leos in attendance, within 12 months of the Institute.

When and where is the Leadership Institute Scheduled to Take Place?

The Regional Leadership Institutes will be offered just prior to the Mid-Year Conference in Georgetown, Guyana from Sunday November 11 to Tuesday November 13, 2001.

How much will the Institute cost?

The costs of hosting the Institute will be covered by a grant from Lions clubs International and financial support from the Multiple Districts and sub-districts. These funds will cover meals, and lodging during the actual days of the Institute. Participants are responsible for their own transportation and related travel expenses to and from the Institute.

Selection Process:

A total of 60 persons from all areas within the Multiple District are being targeted for institute, 30 from 60A and 30 from 60B. Also, it is expected that 30 of the lions selected would qualify as Emerging Lion Leaders and 30 would qualify as Senior Lions. Every effort will be made to place all eligible candidates who meet the acceptance requirements for the program, but. acceptance into the Institute cannot be guaranteed. Candidates will be placed based on the timeliness of their applications after taking into account qualifications as outlined in the application submitted. MD60 intends to conduct a standard of quality in all aspects of the institute, including program, faculty and the selection process for participants. Persons who qualify and are not placed in this Leadership Institute will be given first priority at the next Institute which is being proposed for 2002 in 60B.

Prepare the following items and submit them as indicated below. Your application will be submitted only when all forms are completed:

- 1. Completed Application Form and Statement of Purpose
- 2. Candidate's Lions History Resume
- 3. Candidate's Lion history
- 4. Three letters of nomination from Lion leaders who know you including two from the following list:
