Jerome then led us in a short prayer; Jerome shared a short devotional.


Treasurer's report: George provided the current balance. Donations were collected. Jerome made a motion to spend \$150 to re-stock our chapter PR materials. This motion passed.

Out And About? Watch Out!

You may not know this – I drive **A LOT** for work. I drive all around DE, VA, WV, MD, and DC. I drive at all times of day (sometimes I have to work midnights). So during the last couple of years, I have seen A LOT. Granted, all this time on the road has been in a car, but it is road time. Here are just some of the things I've seen:

Girl flipped her car (I don't know why, but she had her phone in her hand when I got to the car). She was okay.

A biker came up on my right side so fast I almost hit him! My signal was on, I looked in my mirrors, I looked out the windows and I started my lane change – BIKER! Then no biker. His bike was down on the shoulder a bit further up. He was standing, but I never found out what happened.

Bikers weaving in and out of cars like they are standing still. I even saw a biker cut off a semi-truck and then slam on the brakes to make the exit. Good thing the trucker was paying attention because that was a close one.

When merging onto a highway with other bikers, pickup truck driver refused to let me merge into their lane, even though they were exiting and I was entering.
