# Federal Amounts Transferred From Your Spouse or Common-law Partner

Complete this schedule to **claim** a transfer of the unused amount from your spouse's or common-law partner's age amount, amount for children born in 1992 or later, pension income amount, disability amount, and tuition, education, and textbook amounts.

If your spouse or common-law partner is not filing a return, use the amounts that he or she would enter on his or her return, schedules, and worksheet if filing a return. Attach his or her information slips but **do not attach** the return or schedules.

**Age amount** (if your spouse or common-law partner was age 65 or older in 2009):

If his or her income is \$32,312 or less, enter \$6,408; otherwise enter his or her amount for line 301. 353 .00 1

**Amount for children born in 1992 or later:**

Enter his or her amount for line 367. 361 + 2089 .00 2

**Pension income amount:**

Enter his or her amount for line 314. (maximum \$2,000) 355 + .00 3

**Disability amount:**

Enter his or her claim for the disability amount (see line 316 in the guide). 357 + 4

**Tuition, education, and textbook amounts:**

Enter the federal amount designated in your name on his or her Form T2202, T2202A, TL11A, TL11B, or TL11C 360 + 5

Add lines 1 to 5. = 2089 .00 6

His or her taxable income (line 260 of his or her return)

Enter the total of lines 300, 308, 310, 312, 363, 364, 368, 369, and 313 of his or her Schedule 1, plus line 17 of his or her Schedule 11.

His or her adjusted taxable income: Line 7 minus line 8 (if negative, enter "0") 351 = .00 ▶ - .00 9

**Amounts transferred from your spouse or common-law partner:** Line 6 minus line 9 (if negative, enter "0")

Enter this amount on line 326 of Schedule 1. = 2089 .00 10

Complete this schedule to **claim** a transfer of the unused part of your spouse's or common-law partner's territorial amounts indicated below. **Attach a copy** of this schedule to your return.

**If your spouse or common-law partner is not filing a 2009 return, use the amounts that he or she would use on Form NU428 if filing a return.** Attach his or her information slips, but do not attach the return or schedules.

If, at the end of the year, your spouse or common-law partner was not a resident of Nunavut, special rules may apply. Call the Canada Revenue Agency for more details.

**Amount for young children less than 6 years of age:**

Enter the amount from line 5823 of his or her Form NU428 **5900** 1200.00 1

**Age amount** (if he or she was age 65 or older in 2009):

If your spouse's or common-law partner's net income is \$32,312 or less, enter \$8,733.

Otherwise, enter the amount from line 5808 of his or her Form NU428. **5902** + 2

**Pension income amount:**

Enter the amount from line 5836 of his or her Form NU428 (maximum \$2,000) **5905** + 3

**Disability amount:**

Enter the amount from line 5844 of his or her Form NU428 **5907** + 4

**Tuition, education, and textbook amounts:**

Enter the territorial amount designated in your name on his or her Form T2202, T2202A, TL11A, TL11B, or TL11C. **5909** + 5

Add lines 1 to 5 = 1200.00 6

**Spouse's or common-law partner's taxable income:**

Enter the amount from line 260 of his or her return 2500.00 7

Enter the total of lines 5804, 5824, 5828, 5832, 5833, and 5856 of your spouse,s or common-law partner's Form NU428 - 11644.00 8

**Spouse's or common-law partner's adjusted taxable income:**

Line 7 minus line 8 (if negative, enter "0") **5912** = 9

Line 6 minus line 9 (if negative, enter "0")

Enter this amount on line 5864 of your Form NU428. **Territorial amounts transferred from your spouse or common-law partner** = 1200.00 10
