



The Halsey Herreshoff designed T-30 is one of the biggest 30 footers available today. The long waterline (26') and amazing beam (11') combine to produce a spacious live-aboard interior usually found in much larger yachts. Performance has not been compromised. The T-30 is stiff (44% ballast/displacement ratio) and with the tall, powerful % rig this sloop is certainly not a sluggish cruiser.

Belowdecks, the T-30 is both functional and superbly comfortable. There is a navigation station with full size chart table and ample room for instruments. To port, at the foot of the teak companionway is a U-shaped galley complete with S.S. sink, a lot of counter space, a huge icebox with shelf and lots of stowage. The broad beam allows both a good sized L-shaped dinette to port as well as a full sized settee opposite. The head/shower compartment with folding doors stretches to width of the boat.

The Ticon 30 is very fully equipped. A two cylinder diesel is standard as is a pressurized water system. Stainless steel bow and stern rails and integral hinged swimming ladder are also standard safety features. All lines lead aft to the cockpit. Two speed genoa winches and a jiffy reefing are factory installed to make heavier weather easier and safer to handle. A huge cockpit sail locker is more than adequate to take a full sail wardrobe.

The T-30 is a quality yacht that provides comfort without sacrificing performance—all at a very affordable price.
