

- (4) The Brahmin Samaj of Georgia (BSOGA) and the organizers reserve the right to deny admission to any or all persons to any or all evens for any misconduct, misbehavior, and mischief or for any reason that the organizers or the executives of BSOGA deem appropriate in their sole and absolute discretion.
- (5) The Brahmin Samaj of Georgia (BSOGA) and organizers assume no liability to the participant nor do they assume any responsibility or liability for any injury or damage to the person or properties.
- (6) You and your party agree to release, indemnify and hold BSOGA and the organizers harmless from any and all actions and liability of any nature whatsoever, consequential or otherwise, resulting from or relating to this convention and Shubh Milan event.

- (8) **REGISTRATION: FOR CONVENTION DELEGATES:**
 - Eligibility: All Brahmins are encouraged to register and participate.

 - Non-Refundable fees: \$90.00 per person; \$75 per Senior over 65 years of age and \$75.00 per child over 8 years of age.
 - Late Registration: (If available) A late registration fee of \$25, per person will be charged extra. It will not be possible to include their names in the directory.
 - Registration Fees include the following for TWO days: Breakfast, lunch, refreshment. banquet dinner, participation in all seminars and special evening entertainment.
 Notes: (1) ONLY Shubh Milan candidates will be allowed in Shubh Milan events and activities. More details will be handed out during convention.
 - (2) Registration fees do not include motel accommodation.
- (9) Payment must be made by check or money order only (US Currency)
