Designated Bus Lane Sections & Center Lane Change Section

What is the Bus Lane Restriction?

Only buses, taxis with passengers, motorcycles, designated vehicles, and vehicles with permits are allowed to use the bus lane during restricted hours. Rental cars and other general traffic are not permitted to use the bus lane. Restriction hours are in the morning and evening commuting hours every day, with the exception of Saturdays, Sundays and holidays, as well as January 2 and 3.

When confirmed that a vehicle is left behind even for a short period of time, a ticket will be placed on your car, which identifies it as a vehicle left behind/illegally parked.

*Be sure to park in an appropriate parking space even for quick stops.

Please go to the police station written on the ticket and follow routine procedures and pay the fine and other fees! Example of penalty fee and point deduction: When ticketed for leaving behind/illegally parking a standard-sized car in a no parking/stopping area:

○ Fine:15,000Yen ○ Two-point deduction from your driver's license.
*Subject to details of the traffic violation.

When returning your rental car without taking care of your violation procedures, you will be fined a parking violation fee set by our company.

Standard-sized car: 25,000Yen Mid to Large-sized car: 30,000Yen

We will base our procedures as stipulated in the terms and conditions agreed at time of rental contract.

Okinawa's Slippery Roads (Be sure to keep a safe distance between cars)

The asphalt roads on Okinawa contain Ryukyu limestone which can get slippery.

The road condition is at its worst when the rain begins. Even when starting to move slowly when the traffic light changes, you may find your tires slipping. Please be extra cautious and do not start or stop suddenly, and remember to stay below the speed limit.
