









THE HAUNTED BUNGALOW

Print or photocopy the PDF file to a piece of cardstock or index stock. 110 pound is recommended. All lines marked in grey are to be scored and folded. All glue tabs are marked with a G.

To start, glue the right and left halves of the house together. When dry, fold into a box and glue the remaining tab to the inside of the opposing wall. To assemble the front porch, fold down all sides and glue the tabs to the inside. When dry, attach to the front of the house where indicated. Fold down all tabs along the top of the house and glue the roof in place. The fences fold into triangular stand-ups with one “foot” on top of the other. Another method is to glue the two sides together and fold the feet out.
