We all know how uncomfortable it can get wearing a helmet, gloves, long pants, and a jacket/long sleeve shirt in 90 degree heat. Studies have proven that you actually stay cooler when you wear your helmet and gear in hot weather. It also makes riding more enjoyable knowing you are safer and protected from our "four/eighteen wheel" friends. You never know when something unexpected will leap out at you at 65 miles per hour. Being "seen" is one of the most important things you can do when riding a motorcycle.

If you haven't read your September issue of "Wing World" magazine yet, there is a good article on page 14 about just that same thing. It is written by Jim Culp, former rider educator for South Carolina Chapter A. He closes with four tips to be seen. 1) Position your bike so it can be seen & identified in the traffic stream. 2) Wear bright colors. 3) Consider getting a brightly colored bike. 4) PRACTICE your emergency maneuvers. Good advice if you ask me.

Last but not least, we all should get in the habit of doing our inspections on our rides before taking off. Our tires are critical to our Safety. If you have any doubts about the safety of your tires, replace them before you leave home. It could save you some skin or at least some hours sitting waiting for a tire to be brought to you or waiting for that tow truck. Even tires on "Voyager Kits" are important.
