## AEA AFSS WX GRAPHICS BRIEF

The Solicitation went out in FEB 00.

There were only 2 bidders: WSI  
Sterling Software

Sterling did not submit a complete/coherent offer and was therefore disqualified.

KAVOURAS was sent a notification of intent to cancel their contract for convenience on MAR 02, with 10 working days to reply with detailed info ref any cancellation fees, etc.

They did not reply until approx MAR 25.

Their response was inconclusive and unacceptable but nevertheless required a response from us, which has been done but requires approval from AEA Legal. It is expected to go out this week.

Assuming this latest round of official correspondence proceeds at the same pace as the first, it is hoped a contract with WSI may be executed sometime in MAY, and anticipated installation beginning JUN 00.

The Solicitation included all graphics required by 7110.10 and not less than those currently received or those anticipated by OASIS\*.

\*Lightning and the Canadian GFA will be negotiated when it becomes available from WSI. (Both may be available by the time of contract)

Not included in the above is a Graphics Edit Station (1 per facility) that consists of a PC/Monitor/56K Modem/Keyboard & Mouse/Color Printer. This is for back-up, creating local products, editing/enhancing graphics...all "pushable" to all other operating positions.

The entire system consists of Satellite delivered products, Servers, and mouse-controlled, drop-down menu (or click-on) operations.

WSI's Training/Installation program is essentially Cadre.

1 AT and 1 AF person from each facility goes to the first installation site for one day (any of the days in that week).  
4 hr classes (AT/AF each) by WSI.

They then return to their facility awaiting installation. The AF person(s) will make the installation with "help" from a WSI person who will be present on the last day for certification.

The AT person will train the facility's work force on operating the system during installation. (*It's not rocket science*).

DCA has been chosen tentatively as the FIRST site because:

Easy to fly to from BUF/ISP  
Easy to drive to from EKN/AOO/IPT/MIV

Order of remaining sites is up to the facilities.
