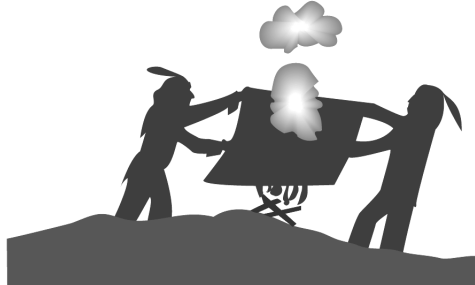

Salvation Army Kettle Report for 2011



We all did a really great job bringing in \$4,850 this year which is about 20% more than last years \$4,000. Perhaps the early start this year and picking the last two days before Christmas were helpful.

25 kettles = 25 men @ 2hrs each = 50 hours
\$4,850 = \$97.00 per hr. per kettle

And to think, your real reward will probably be in Heaven! Also again this year we salute our senior bell ringer the 94 year old Bruce Bell and his helpful wife, Gert. Also John Holcomb and his half dozen Edison Builders Club musicians.

The Salvation Army surpassed its campaign goal of \$325,000 by raising \$327,000. This amounts to about 40% of its annual budget.

We had a couple suggestions. One, starting at 8 a.m. and Major Bob said they would study it further. We also had several complaints of overfilled kettles and I offered to put one of our people on that job. Major Bob said that sounded like a good idea as getting volunteers was the name of the game.

On Thursday, January 19th between 5 and 7 P.M. Major Bob Fey and his wife Ruth hosted the annual Bell Ringers banquet starting with a world class chili – all we could eat and many desserts.

Awards were passed out to individuals who brought in from \$500.00 to \$3,700.00 and then on to clubs such as ours. First place went to Salvation Army Woman's Auxiliary at \$8,000.00, Second place to Golden Kiwanis at \$4,850.00 and Third place to American Legion at \$3,500.00. Rocky Schroeder and his wife, Sue, accompanied me in accepting the presentation of the Achievement Award.
