

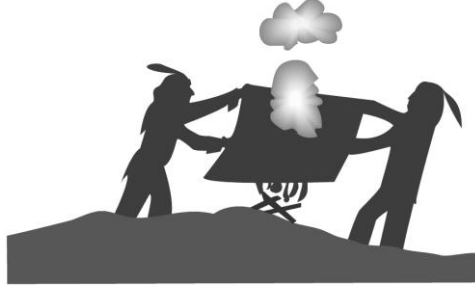

Secretary's Report:

Submitted as published in the July Smoke Signal and approved.

Treasurer's Report:

Will Reck gave an update on the tree sales which netted the club \$831. Disbursements included checks in the amount of \$500 each to the Salvation Army, ECHO, Boy Scouts, Girl Scouts and the Boys and Girls Club plus \$750 to the Kiwanis International Foundation. Will also reported that the Administrative Account balance is healthy and well funded to cover all of our administrative needs for the current fiscal year.

Old Business:

Financial Review Update: Dave Peterson gave an overview of the revised policy in regards to how we handle the collection of money from fundraisers such as Peanut and Lily Day. A motion was made to approve the changes and seconded. The motion was unanimously approved.

Tree Sales Update: Glenn Disrude and Maury Frey reported on the Board's recommendation that next years tree sale be a 1 day sale with fewer trees being ordered and run exclusively by Blackhawk Golden "K" at Rotary Gardens. This means that there will be no splitting of the profits.

Hixson/Zeller Awards Report: Will Reck announced that money is available for 3 awards and after some discussion, the Board agreed to being comfortable with the process for the selection of award recipients.

Awards/Installation Banquet: Glenn Disrude gave an update on the agenda for the awards banquet and how it will be run.

Kiwanis Park Watering Update: Discussion centered on improving the process for watering and improvements in staffing by using the sign-up sheet.

Sons of Norway Parking:

Glenn Disrude has been communicating with the Sons of Norway and city about ways to accommodate member parking from 9-11 a.m. with the use of stickers to display in their cars.

Traxler Park Sign: No action concerning the Traxler Park Sign. We're waiting to hear information on the processes to follow and costs involved with the city.

Janesville Farmer's Market: John Janes commented on the need to contact the Farmer's Market people in regards to acquiring a space for setting up a booth and the value of continuing with this project.

New Business:

Thank You Letter: Glenn Disrude announced the drafting of a letter to the Gazette to thank the community from Kiwanis for support throughout the year for all of our projects.

Homeless Funding: Glen Jablonka talked about wanting to continue with funding the Homeless Fund Project for K-12 kids that are in the Janesville School District. Golden "K" contributed \$2,000 last year and a decision will be made after further discussion and Board approval.

Truck on Ice: Glen Jablonka gave an update on T.O.I. policies and procedures on how and where we sell tickets.
