

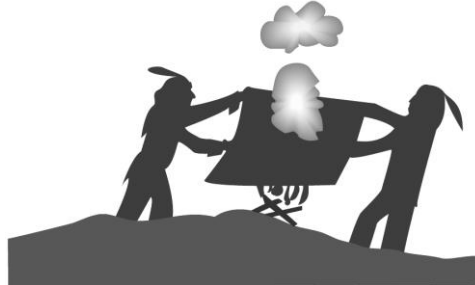

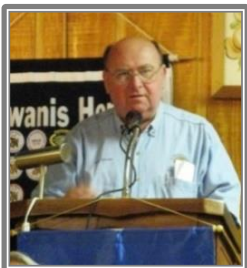

On Wednesday, May 27th, five members visited our Kiwanis sponsored club, the Builder's Club at Edison Middle School.

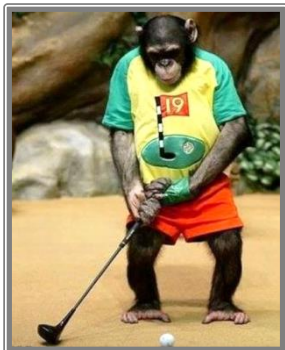
A review of the years activities was presented. A treat of pizza, cookies, and drinks were available.
