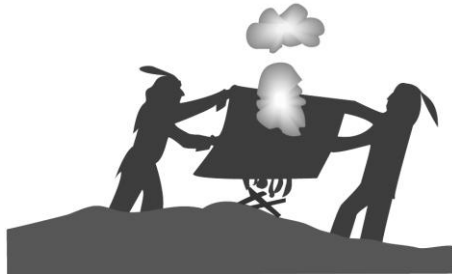

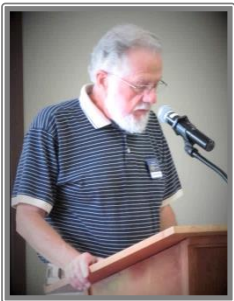

Secretary's Report:

Minutes were approved as printed in the Smoke Signal.

Treasurer's Report:

Will reported that all accounts are in good shape and moved to file the report as submitted and was seconded by Don Anderson and approved.

----- **OLD BUSINESS** -----

Truck on Ice:

John Janes stated that the T.O.I. committee will meet after Jan. 1st to get the table sales set up and that there will probably be a need for a replacement for Mauer's Grocery Store since they are going out of business. Jerry Burhans brought up the issue of implementing a policy that accounts for all tickets sold and unsold. John Janes said that he would address to the membership the need to return all tickets by the due date for transparency and accountability.

Tax Exempt Status:

Tom Neumann informed the Board of a \$600 IRS Filing Fee for tax- exempt status plus an annual renewal fee. It was decided that the Board needs more information about fees before moving forward.

Scholarships:

It was brought up to the Board of a contract that was in place with the University of Wisconsin-Rock County and Blackhawk Golden K regarding our commitment to provide scholarships to a number of students each year. The Board voted a year ago to discontinue this practice for a number of reasons. The financial situation of our club and the desire to help more children were the main reasons for this decision. Since there was no expiration date on this agreement, it was decided that the club should respond with a letter or phone call to U-WI. Rock Co. informing them of our decision. Paul Neitzel agreed to handle this matter.

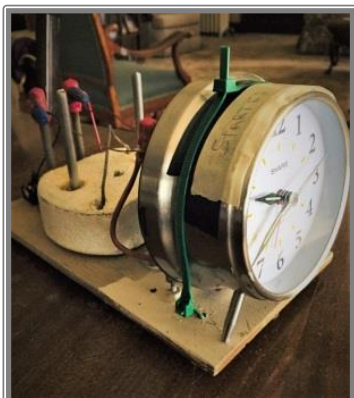
