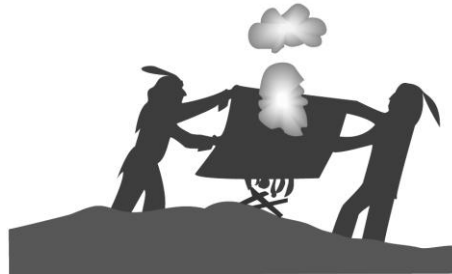

Secretary's Report:

Greg Turco went over the current financial statement with the Board and stated that all accounts are liquid and all of the checks have been sent out to the charitable organizations that we budgeted for. The report was filed as submitted and approved.

Truck on Ice:

John Janes explained how the Truck on Ice fundraiser will need to be changed due to Covid 19 protocols. We can't do business in the usual way due to health concerns and will have to get creative and come up with new ways to generate revenue. John made a motion to proceed with the Truck on Ice fundraiser in spite of these challenges and difficulties and was seconded by Paul Neitzel and approved.

David Thill is heading up the T.O.I. project and has formed a committee to discuss how we are going to go about raising the necessary money to have a successful fundraiser. Some of the concerns are how to sell tickets and the amounts of the prize money. Wayne Olson made a motion to lower the top prize from \$3,000 down to \$2,000 and leave all of the other prizes the same. Tom Neumann seconded that motion and was approved by the Board.

John Janes also made a motion to have February 13th as the final date for selling tickets so we can get the necessary information to the printer. This motion was approved by the Board as well.

The Board is still looking for a person to volunteer for the position of **Vice President**.

The Board is also looking for someone to take on the task of being our new Smoke Signal Editor. Dave Peterson has resigned as the Smoke Signal Editor and the October issue of the Smoke Signal will be his last.
