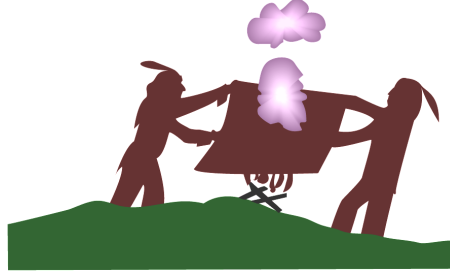

**Secretary's Report**

Paul reported that our official membership total for 2020/2021 is at 48 members and that we are still waiting for the invoice for membership dues payment to Kiwanis International, which should be about \$5,200.

Greg is working on the 2020/2021 budget statement but informed the Board of the difficulty of such a document due to not knowing what kind of income will be coming in due to fewer fundraising opportunities. Tom Neumann moved to file the report as submitted and was seconded by Paul Neitzel and approved.

**Bylaws and Club Policies**

Linda presented to the Board copies of the club bylaws and policies, which were last submitted to Kiwanis International in 2018. Linda suggested the need to update this document such as reflecting the fact that we have moved to a new location, different activities that we are doing or not doing etc. Linda would like to organize a committee to work on this document and then present to the Board for approval and submission to Kiwanis International.

**Christmas Party**

Due to health concerns, the Board felt that the traditional Kiwanis Christmas party should be altered to something less formal such as having Mocha Moments supply at our December 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting a little treat to go along with our coffee and donuts. Nothing has been decided yet but the Board will discuss this topic again at our November Board meeting

Bob Douglas has been in charge of the year end appeal but due to health issues, Maury Frey has graciously consented to take over this year's year end appeal.

**Change in Club Direction**

Gregg Dickinson introduced the idea of our club looking into ways we might want to help people, especially the elderly single male population who are dealing with depression, suicidal thoughts, loneliness and other issues by trying to get them involved in something of a social nature. Our club will have a speaker in the near future that will address this topic and show us how we can get involved. Gregg mentioned that the mission of Kiwanis is to help the children of the world but that this is something important that we can also do in our own community to help others. It would also be an area where we could attract new members

**Fund Raising**

Gregg Dickinson showed the Board a banner with the logo of the Janesville Pediatric/Dental Association that will go on our Kiwanis Truck On Ice featured in the Jolly Jingle Parade. They donated \$2,000 to our club towards the T.O.I. fundraiser.
