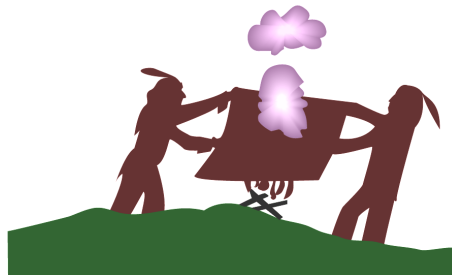

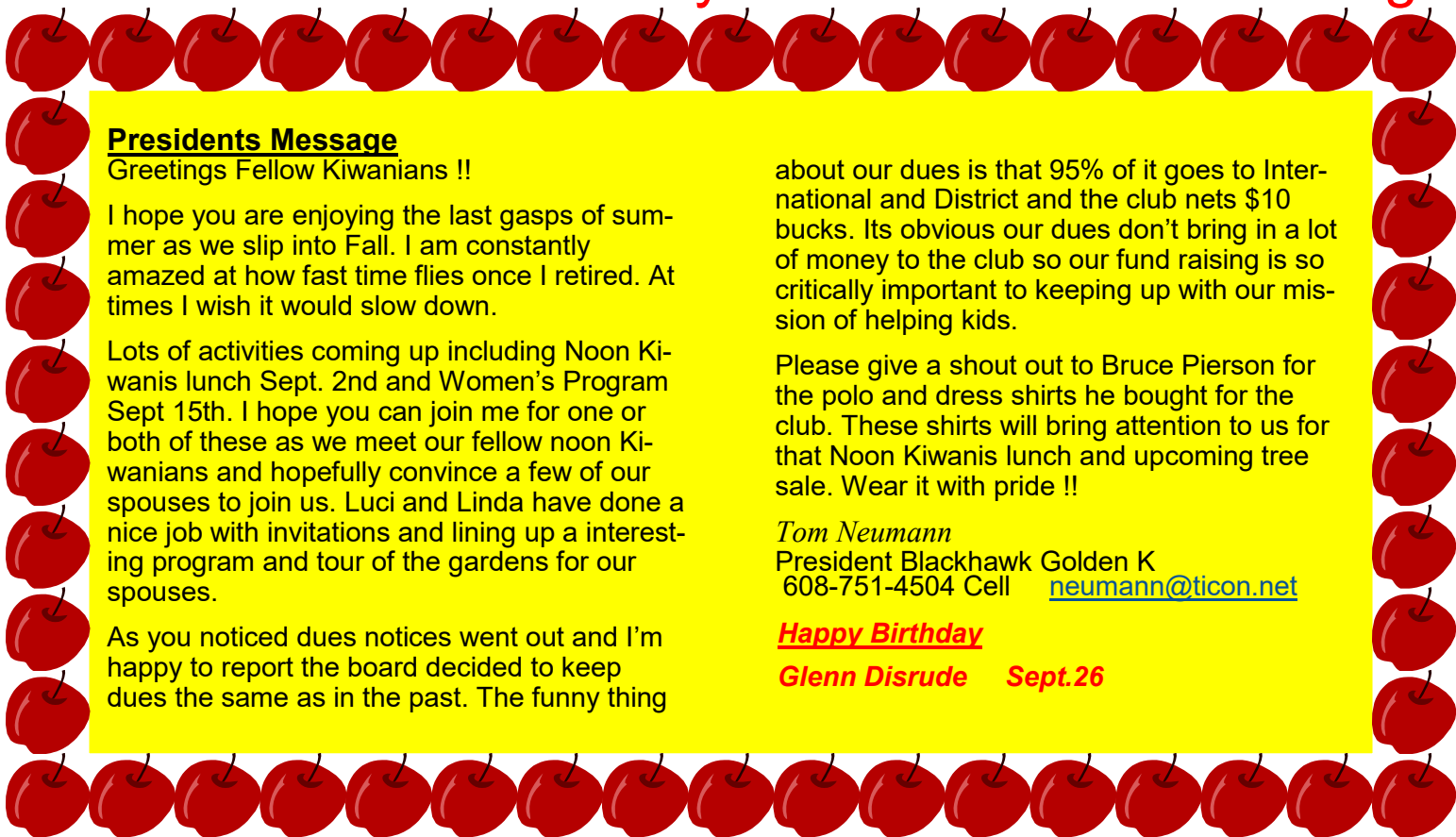

Paul Neitzel informed the Board of distributing the annual dues notices to the membership and that the dues were set at \$120, the same as the last two years. The dues should be paid by Sept 29th. The minutes were approved as printed in the Smoke Signal

Treasurers' Report:

Greg Turco stated that the Administrative Account saw an increase of \$2396, which was primarily due to a \$2000 donation for the membership drive. Our Service Account went down by \$7123 because of donations to the following: Rotary Gardens, District Foundation, Janesville Schools Early Literacy, Janesville Multicultural Teachers Scholarship, Badgerland Girl Scouts, Camp Wawbeek (Easter Seals) and the Janesville Schools' Bags of Hope. Discussion about adding the Janesville Community Center to our list of charitable organizations was tabled for further discussion at another Board meeting and the need for more information. Greg also pointed out that the IRS has begun processing our appeal to the fine related to our tax exempt status. The review should be done by Sept. 22.

New shirts and hats are on order. Several members have offered suggestions which will be included in our final plan. Final approval for expenditures will be required from the BOD. Membership Committee

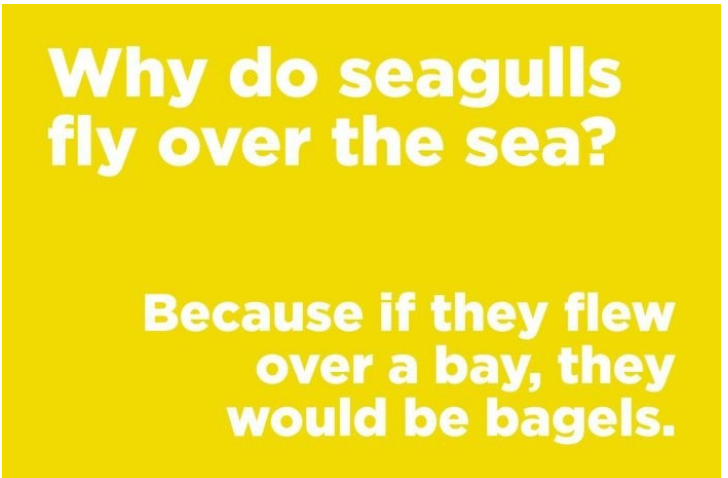
Meals on Wheels
