REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS

The horse must show evidence of being Painted and/or Gaited. The ideal horse possesses a smooth ride with unique markings. The term **Painted** refers to any unusual markings that can be distinguished from the typical solid colored horse, such as markings above the knee or hock, extended facial markings, or exhibiting contrasting colors on the tail or skin. The application must be accompanied by <u>4 color photos</u>, one of each side, one front, and one back. Good photos are very important since one of the photos will be used on the Registration Certificate.

The term **<u>Gaited</u>** refers to a horse that exhibits a gait other than a standard trot. The application must also be accompanied by a short video or signed video waiver form to pass inspection for Gaited along with the appropriate fee.


