DIRECTIONS TO GOLF COURSE

- From Toronto take Highway 401 West
- From London take Highway 401 East
- Exit on Highway 8
- From Highway 8 - take Exit for Highway 7/8 West
- Exit at Regional Road 12
- Turn left at Snyder's Road
- Rebel Creek is located on the left hand side

DIRECTIONS TO HOTEL

From East

- Follow Highway 401 West
- Take Exit 278 (Shantz Hill Road/Cambridge)
- Turn left onto Shantz Hill Road and then turn right onto Preston Parkway
- The hotel is on the right hand side of the road

From North

- Take Highway 8 towards Cambridge/Highway 401 West/London
- Take a slight right turn on to King Street East/Provincial Route 8
- Continue on Provincial Route 8
- Turn right on to Preston Parkway

From West

- Follow Highway 401 East
- Take Exit 278 (Shantz Hill Road)
- Keep right and turn right on to Preston Parkway
- The hotel is on the right hand side of the road

From South

- Go Northwest on King Street East/Provincial Route 8 toward Eagle Street
- Turn left on to Fountain Street
- Take a slight right turn on to Shantz Hill Road
- Turn left on to Preston Parkway

DIRECTIONS FROM HOTEL TO GOLF COURSE

Head northeast on Preston Pkwy toward Linden Drive. Turn left at Highway 8 West. Merge onto Highway 8 West via the ramp to Kitchener/Waterloo. Take exit onto Highway 7/8 West toward Stratford. Take Regional Road 12/Queen Street exit toward New Dundee/Notre Dame Drive/Petersburg. Keep left at the fork, follow signs for Waterloo Road 12 S/New Dundee. Turn left at Queen Street/Regional Road 12 (signs for Waterloo Road 12 South). Destination will be on the right. Trip – approximately 20 minutes (14 miles/20 km).

HOSPITALITY SUITE

Registration will be held at the Four Points by Sheraton commencing at 6:30pm on Friday.

Food will be served, cash bar.

Players may enter for the skills and skins competitions at this time (if not done with registration).

All teams must be submitted at this time as well (at cost of \$50/team).

CLASSES

MEN

Masters – 0-7, **A** – 8-14, **B** – 15-20, **C** – 21-26, **D** – 27-36, **Seniors** (65+)

WOMEN

A – 0-39, **B** – 40+

TEE TIMES

Set tee times both days. Saturday start at 10:00am; Sunday start at 11:00am.

RULES

Masters and Mens A Classes will play from the blue/gold tees; Mens B, C, D from the blue tees; Seniors from the white tees; all Women from the red tees. All hazards will be treated as lateral and a one stroke penalty applies. A ball in your fairway may be moved six inches, no closer to the hole. Maximum score on a hole is 10. All other RCGA rules apply.



SPECIALTY HOLES

Closest to the pin competitions will be held on both Saturday & Sunday – holes TBA.

Longest drive competition will be held on Sunday – holes TBA.

SCORE CARDS

Turn into pro shop after round.

INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION

Awards will be given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd low gross and 1st place low net in all classes. Only one individual award per player with gross scores determined first. Seniors (65+) and Juniors will play in their classes (i.e. Masters, A, B, C, D) and may receive awards in the specialty category and their class. There is also a special award for the Senior who has the best 18 hole score minus their age. All awards and prizes will be given out at the banquet.

SKILLS CONTESTS

On Saturday all players are invited to enter the chipping, putting and closest to the pin (on the 19th hole island green) contests. The entry fee is \$5 per contest and cash prizes will be awarded for 1st and 2nd place finishes in each.

TEAMS

Men's teams are made up of 6-9 players, with the best six scores counted for each day's total. The two day total is then counted for the team score. Awards are given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd team low gross and first place team low net. Women's teams consist of 4-7 players with the best four scores counted for each day's total. The two day total is then counted for the team score. Awards are given for 1st, 2nd and 3rd low gross and 1st place low net. Teams may only win one award.

TIE BREAKER

Sudden death playoff is for 1st place individual low gross in the Men's Masters only. All other ties will be broken using RCGA tie breaking criteria (comparing Sunday's back nine scores then if still tied, comparing Sunday's last 6 holes, then if still tied, comparing Sunday's last 3 holes, then if still tied, comparing Sunday's 18th hole).
