PROPOSAL

A Proposal has been submitted to the DNR that both the first and second buck a hunter harvests in Montcalm County will have at least four-points-on-one-side minimum (all antler points must be at least 1" or more in length to qualify). The antlerless harvest will need to include enough females (the taking of button bucks is strongly discouraged) to meet DMU population goals and achieve an adult buck to doe ratio of 1:2 or lower.

A survey vote is being proposed for December 2002. If passed, the proposal would become an enforceable game law in Montcalm County for a minimum of 5 years beginning with the Fall 2003 Hunting Season.
