**Proposals for full-day** (6 hours' duration) or **half-day** (3 hours' duration) **tutorials** are also invited. Tutorial proposals should have (i) Tutorial title and short summary (in about 200 words), (ii) Name, affiliation and contact details of the co-coordinating presenter and all other co-presenters, (iii) Target audience and prerequisites along with beneficial impact of the tutorial on the intended participants (in about 75 words), (iv) detailed tutorial program, delineated sub-topic-wise description of the structure with time duration of each (in about 200 words), (v) short biographical sketch of each presenter (in about 200 words for each presenter).

**Proposals for embedded tutorials** (1 hour duration) are also invited. The proposals must include the full papers. **Panel discussion** proposals must be submitted together with details of the topics, their relevance and the conflicts they will address, together with names of panelists.
